## October 6, 2018 Chili Cookoff Rules & Entry Form

## Use of the Community Center Kitchen is NOT allowed.

1. The Chili Cookoff is open to all competitors, either individuals or teams.

2. Chili must be cooked on-site (beans may be soaked overnight). No other entries will be allowed.

3. There is no entry fee. Cash prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place, and the 1<sup>st</sup> Place winners name will be placed on the San Antonio Valley Community Center perpetual plaque that will remain on the wall at the community center.

4. Create a minimum of 3 gallons of your favorite chili recipe. You can make more if you like...just remember...the more chili you have, the more you can give out, thus increasing your chances of getting votes.

5. Chili **MUST** be kept hot. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own ingredients, utensils, cooking surface (i.e. portable stove, BBQ pit, etc), tables, canopy if you wish, and setup. The community center will provide cups, spoons, napkins. Everyone at your booth must wear sanitary gloves.

6. You may include condiments of your choice as well as bread, cornbread, crackers, tortillas, etc. Your chili must be ready for serving by 1:00 pm.

7. All proceeds from the sale of tickets will go towards the benefit of the San Antonio Valley Community Center.

8. Leftover chili at the end of the day may be sold with proceeds going to the contestant.
